Rosamund's Victory—£16.00/£15.00



Maidlin has unknown cousins—who don't want her interfering in their lives! The Lake District scenery forms a lovingly-described backdrop to the story.



Four titles originally published by Muller that tell of the development of the younger generation of **Abbey Girls** in much more detail than the **Collins** titles that appeared at much the same time




